3 – 7 July 2000

Our first tournament in Europe saw us playing at the Hartl Golf Resort, Bad Griesbach in Southern Germany close to the Austrian Boarder. Three wonderful golf courses were used for the tournament the Brunnwies, Uttlau and Sigmuhle Golf Courses. All courses were located near to the Headquarters Hotel, which was the Golfhotel Maximilian. The tournament was played on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> July, Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> July, Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> July and Friday 7<sup>th</sup> July 2000.

The Lady Champion was Claudia Popp, Germany.
