

MINUTES OF EXTRAORDINARY MEETING, FLORIDA U.S.A. 30 SEPTEMBER
2010

Time commenced 3pm.

1. Moved Tony Broadhurst, seconded Tom Waki that a new position of Vice Chairman be created. CARRIED.
2. Moved Erv Frose, seconded Leif Olsson. The Chairman will be independent and will not be his Country Representative. CARRIED.
3. Moved Richard Davison, seconded Erv Frose the 25th WALG tournament be allocated to Australia. CARRIED.

Election of Vice Chairman:

Leif Olsson proposed by Tony Broadhurst, seconded Erv Frose.

Richard Davison proposed by Martin Poertner, lapsed for the want of a seconder.

Leif Olsson elected Vice Chairman.

During the meeting Martin Poertner raised the question if Doug Crosby was the NALG representative from Australia. The Chairman stated that he was and always had been since the inception of WALG, further that he had been Chairman of NALG (Aust) for over 20 years and at present he was their Patron and Life Member. Martin Poertner again questioned his authority to represent Australia and that an Australian, Graham Kelly had told him that Doug Crosby did not represent NALG (Aust)

As a result of this doubt and immediately after this meeting, Peter Read approached Mr Bert Adams Secretary NALG (Aust) who was present in Florida at the WALG Championship to clarify the situation. It was agreed by Mr. Adams that Doug Crosby had always represented NALG (Aust) at the WALG tournaments and to his knowledge, that authority had never been removed by NALG (Aust).
