1. Minutes of previous meeting read and adopted.

4. Change guidelines to ensure cocktail party held on night prior to first round.
5. Bob Zimmerman gave overview of Canadian event for 2003. Expected numbers called for, Australia 25-35, Japan 50, Ireland 15, Taiwan 20-30, Germany 15, Finland 5, Sweden 5, England 30, other could be expected from N.Z, Switzerland, Spain.
