1. Minutes of previous meeting adopted and signed.
2. Discussion took place regarding the venue for the next World Championship. Spain and Canada discussed. Tournament allocated to Spain June 2 to 8, 2002.
3. Future venues were discussed. The following dates and venues were agreed to:
  - \* 2003 Canada June or September
  - \* 2005 Ireland June
  - \* 2006 Taiwan October/November.
  - \* 2008 N. Z. February
  - \* 2009 U.S.A (Malaysia)
4. Some discussion took place in regard to allowing competitors to putt right handed. Agreed to unanimously to retain our current condition of play.
5. A tournament format which allows for the movement up and down only one flight was discussed and lost.
6. A number of issues were raised in relation to the use of motorised buggies. It was agreed to include in the WALG Tournament Guidelines the following:
  - \* If sufficient motorised buggies for everyone, then anyone can use a motorised buggy.
  - \* If restricted numbers of motorised buggies are available, then those available should only be for competitors in the Senior Division only.
  - \* If insufficient to service all Senior Competitors, then only competitors with medical certificates will be allowed to use motorised buggies.
  - \* It is the responsibility of the organising Country to include in their condition of play, suitable controls to manage motorised buggies.
  - \* Where there are limited numbers of motorised buggies, this information is to be included in the tournament proposal.
7. NAME / COUNTRY tags to be provided and worn by all competitors.
8. Future tournaments to be either Monday/Tuesday - Thursday/Friday or Thursday/Friday

Monday/Tuesday.
