Emeritus Life Membership: Nominated by Tom Waki that Peter Read be awarded this prestigious position seconded by Tony Broadhurst and carried.


A discussion was held with regards to presentation of certificates for all who had achieved twenty tournaments a motion was put to this and was also carried
